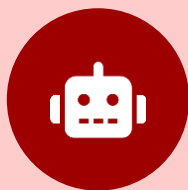
FINANCE HAS MOVED FROM COUNTING THE PAST TO PREDICTING THE FUTURE

The volume of business data and the power to analyse it have exploded. As guardians of organisational data, finance teams are now expected to turn that data into forward-looking insight — not just historical reports.



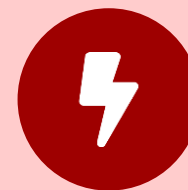

SETTING THE FOUNDATION

WHAT IS DATA ANALYTICS IN FINANCE?

DEFINITION

Data analytics is the disciplined process of collecting, cleaning, exploring and interpreting data to produce insight that supports better business and financial decisions.

For finance professionals, it means moving beyond "what the numbers say" to "what we should do next."

1**Collect & clean**

Pull data from systems, spreadsheets and external sources; fix gaps and errors.

2**Explore & analyse**

Apply techniques to find patterns, trends and relationships in the numbers.

3**Visualise**

Turn analysis into clear dashboards and charts decision-makers can read fast.

4**Decide & act**

Translate insight into pricing, budgeting, risk and strategy decisions.

THE CORE CONCEPT

THE FOUR TYPES OF ANALYTICS

The ACCA certificate is built around leveraging all four — together they answer the full decision-making question.



DESCRIPTIVE

What happened?

Reporting on past performance — revenue, margins, variances.



DIAGNOSTIC

Why did it happen?

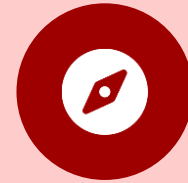
Drilling into causes behind a cost spike or sales dip.



PREDICTIVE

What is likely next?

Forecasting cash flow, demand and credit risk.



PRESCRIPTIVE

What should we do?

Recommending the best action to optimise the outcome.

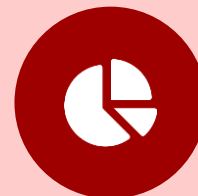
